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TRAINING OVERVIEW

PRE-LICENSE TRAINING

Foundations for Strong Families and Supportive Communities is a Biblically informed pre-licensing course approved by the State of Florida for foster and adoptive parents. This training aims to equip potential foster parents with the skills and knowledge they need to effectively care and advocate for foster children.

Throughout this course, participants will learn about the Florida foster care system, trauma, managing behaviors, and advocating for the best interest of foster children.

IN-SERVICE TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

Fostering Our Future Academy (FOFA) is a competency-based professional in-service training program for Foster Families and child welfare professionals. Monthly in service modules provide up to 15 training hours per annum from leading subject matter experts in the community-based child welfare movement. FOFA training hours qualify for annual foster home licensing renewal.

VOLUNTEER TRAINING

Foster Teams Wrap-Around Support Training is the backbone of our success. We believe that foster family support teams should be trained specifically to assist foster families. As there are different levels of support volunteers, we have created different levels of training so no matter what role is chosen, there is training to equip them. Wraparound support training uses selected topics through our Foundations Pre-License Training on-line classes.
